Note:

If K-3 teachers were educated in accredited undergraduate programs in Ohio, then we routinely waive EDL 511 or EDL 512 from the Reading Endorsement requirements.

*Although our program is technically listed as "20 hours" it typically works out for most teachers to be "17 hours" due to the flexibility in allowing (1) course from their undergraduate work to count towards the Reading Endorsement.
