## **CTU NEGOTIATIONS SURVEY**

Have you given your initial input to the CTU Negotiations Committee yet? The committee is looking for your input. Please see the email that was sent on September 15 from the CTU. The last day to complete this survey is Sunday, September 27.

This initial survey is for all CTU members. Future surveys will be broken down by chapter (paraprofessional, related service provider, teacher, substitute, etc.). Thank you in advance for your time and input as we prepare for a successful contract negotiation. Your voice matters to help us bring back a contract that is fair for all members and allows us all to do our jobs the way we know is best for our schools and our students.

## **BATTELLE PORTAL COMPENSATION**

The Battelle portal has been reopened for anyone that still needs to confirm data for the Cleveland Differentiated Compensation System (CDCS). Please login and verify your information by noon on Monday, September 18. By logging in and verifying, you help ensure that all of your data is accurate. The portal is open for teachers and related service providers to verify their number of ACs, attendance above 95% (for \$280 bonus), etc. This is each member's chance to verify the accuracy of the data.

Go to My Awards, click on the dollar amount on the "Award Amount" line and see a detailed description of ACs and bonuses.

If you can't remember your password or you are new to the BFK-Ohio portal, click on the "Forgot Password?" link, and an e-mail with a code will be sent to the username e-mail address in order to establish a password.

Please follow the instructions in the e-mail for additional guidance. The CMSD Help Desk does not manage these passwords. Please use the link above instead.

## **OVERAGES**

Overage forms are in the building and are with either your principal or secretary. Forms are to be sent to payroll by September 25. No teacher should be asked to copy IEPs nor should any teacher copy IEPs for proof of students. Directions and what is needed for documentation is on the forms and is clearly indicated – and it is not IEPs.

## **3<sup>RD</sup> GRADE GUARANTEE**

This email was sent via CMSD email on Monday regarding AIMSweb. Just in case you did not see it, I am reprinting here.

We are still working with Pearson to update AIMSWeb and correct the errors in the system. At this time, we are still requesting that no users access the system for any reason because any system changes can compromise the validity of the data collection process. You will receive an email indicating that the system is open once all issues have been resolved. All passwords will also be reset at that time.

Because of the system problems, we have decided to extend the assessment window adding one additional week. All AIMSWeb fall benchmark assessments must be completed and entered into the system by October 3, 2015 . Remember, you may still complete the assessment using the paper and pencil method if you choose. Updates will be sent out through Curriculum and Instruction as well as CAO updates and email.

Please do not have parents sign off on RIMPS because RIMPS must be created once the NWEA assessment window is closed. At this time, you will receive information regarding the changes in SchoolNET around the RIMP development process as well as new signature pages. Remember that when parents sign the signature page, they must be informed of the entire RIMP (student cut score, identified deficit in reading, intervention designed (with strategies described), schedule of intervention to be received (amount of time/days per week) as well as progress monitoring information). Be sure to share the on-going progress with the parents also. Again, watch for updates regarding this process. They will be sent out in the next few weeks.

### FALL STAFFING ADJUSTMENTS

If your building interviewed candidates this week for open positions - Friday, September 25 at 4:30 is the due date for all paperwork from the Personnel Selection Committee. Additionally, all email acceptances of positions must also be received by HR by 4:30 on the 25<sup>th</sup>. Anyone that is an NT that was not selected or did not interview will be assigned on Monday, September 28 by HR. September 29 is pack day and September 30 is move to new school day. All new assignments start on October 1.

#### PACK & MOVE DAYS

Teachers (and paraprofessionals) being transferred for any reason from one building to another during the school year shall receive 1 day (with no pupils) to pack up in their old assignment and shall receive 1 day (with no pupils) in the new building in order to become organized. Teachers whose assignment has changed within the building during the school year, which requires a grade level or classroom move or change, shall receive 1 day with no pupils to pack and unpack for the new assignment.
